## POTATO SQUARE

Potato Square is a nickname used by locals for Ylioppilasaukio, located at the corner of Mannerheimintie and Kaivokatu between the student union buildings. The square got its name from French fries that arrived in Finland 1959, when students sold them there as part of a fundraising. Although the name Potato Square has never appeared on official maps, it became a lasting part of the city's urban culture.

Thanks to its location and its exotic offerings, Potato Square quickly became a popular meeting place for young people – the forecourt of the students union buildings, where people gathered before heading indoors or returning home. Today, the summer terrace of Hansa Café Bar & Brasserie continues this social tradition.
